DIPLOMA ARTISTI ITALIANI



he award "DIPLOMA ARTISTI ITALIANI" consists of a set of 10 awards each one issued for a specific Italian artist of the past (see point A))

Every award may be requested individually by OM/SWL who are able to abide by the following points :

European stations

- 1. spell the name of the artist for the award you are applying for by using the <u>last letter</u> of any Italian callsign
- 2. spell the name of the same artist by using the <u>first letter</u> of the suffix of any Italian callsign
- 3. 5 QSO/HRD with the call area I3 (but not IN3 and IV3) of which at least one must be from Venice or province of Venice (ZIP 30xxx).

DX stations (AF, AN, AS, NA, SA, OC)

- 1. spell the name of the artist for the award you are applying for by using the <u>last letter</u> of any Italian callsign
- 2. spell the name of the same artist by using the <u>first letter</u> of the suffix of any Italian callsign

Callsigns of foreign operators operating portable in Italy are not accepted for these awards and also callsigns of San Marino (T7), SMOM (1A) and the Vatican (HV) are not valid for these awards.

All callsigns listed in your application may be used only once.

QSO/HRD validity 1.1.1985. Endorsement may by requested by band/mode.

QSL cards must be in possession of the applicant. The award manager may request one or more copies of the QSL in case of doubt.

The award is free, and sent via email as a PDF file (JPG on request).
