

COLOSSEUM



Diploma

The diploma "COLOSSEUM" has been established to remember this famous amphitheatre, the largest in the world, capable of 50 to 80,000 spectators. It is situated in the center of the city of Rome, and originally it was known as "Amphitheatrum Flavium". Construction began in 72 A.D. under the rule of emperor Vespasianus and was completed in 80 A.D. by emperor Titus.

The award is issued to OM/SWL who abide by the following 2 conditions :

EUROPEAN STATIONS

1. Spell the words "AMPHITHEATRUM FLAVIUM" using the last letter of any Italian callsign. Foreign stations working portable in Italy are not accepted and stations from San Marino, the Vatican and the SMOM are also not accepted for this award plus

2. 1 QSO/HRD with each of the following provinces of Lazio, the Region of Rome (call area I0):

- Frosinone (FR) initial ZIP code 03xxx
- Latina (LT) initial ZIP code 04xxx
- Rieti (RI) initial ZIP code 02xxx
- Roma initial ZIP code 00xxx
- Viterbo (VT) initial ZIP code 01xxx

Your application will contain 25 QSO/HRD.

STATIONS FROM AFRICA, ASIA, NORTH & SOUTH AMERICA, OCEANIA

1. Spell the words "AMPHITHEATRUM FLAVIUM" using the last letter of any Italian callsign. Foreign stations working portable in Italy are not accepted and stations from San Marino, the Vatican and the SMOM are also not accepted for this award. (20 QSO/HRD in total)
