# **WORKED ITALIAN PREFIXES**



## Diploma

his set of 3 different certificates may be requested by OM/SWL who have worked/heard the required number of prefixes used by Italian OMs, and have received QSL cards.

To identify a prefix the same rules as for the renowned WPX award apply. For example, I1, I2, I3, I4, IZ0, IZ1, IZ2 etc. are all different prefixes. Prefix with no number, i.e. I/IK3GER, counts as I0/IK3GER.

For the purpose of this diploma prefixes used by stations operating from San Marino (T7), SMOM (1A0), the Vatican City (HV) and foreign hams operating portable in Italy (ex. IL7/DL5AA) are not accepted.

At present, there are more than 100 different prefixes used by Italian hams (block IAAZ-IAZZ). Accordingly, the certificate will be issued in 3 different classes according to the number of prefixes worked/heard.

#### Class 3

For QSO/HRD with 30 or more different prefixes

#### Class 2

For QSO/HRD with 50 or more different prefixes

#### Class 1

For QSO/HRD with 100 or more different prefixes.

The award is free, and sent out via email as a PDF file (JPG on request).

Endorsement available by band and mode.

QSO/HRD validity 1.1.1985.

QSL cards must be in possession of the applicant.

Send a list of stations worked/heard in order of prefix as shown in the example below.

Confirmations via LOTW and eQsI accepted.
